  - Local merchandise being considered for 2<sup>nd</sup> tent in STEM City
  - National will send point of use devices for sales
  - Recommend "come see AFA" publicity, perhaps on webpage
  - o Alex will pull Randy into the next phone call with National
- Snow Ball Express
  - Angie motioned \$500 donation and Scotty 2nd
  - Donations offset costs of teddy bears, t-shirts and dog tags this year
  - o Publicity planned incudes Fox13 and Airman Magazine
  - o 36 total volunteers this year with Alex, Randy and Bob the only Ch 235
  - o Considering possible UT Gold Star Kid event next year (approx. 34 kids)
- Chapter Documents needing to be completed for stipend
  - o Roster submitted
  - Activity Plan draft sent and reviewed/commented via email prior
  - o Financial Plan
    - The majority of the rest of the meeting focused on line-by-line review of the Activity Plan as a building block for the Financial Plan
    - J/ROTC units needing funding was discussed
      - Alex spoke with cadets from the U and they do have an active Arnold Air Society and will need some help getting cadets to New Orleans for NATCON this year
