 - o Jim suggests \$100 donation
 - Randy concurs and Mike seconds

 - o Looking for judges, referees, volunteers this time next month will know numbers needed
 - Trying to get National to hold national finals here
 - o 7 HS teams signed up already
- Merchandise booth for Air Show
 - o At AFA National Larry Spencer mentioned Andrews Air Show merchandise booth
 - AFA made \$2500 in sales for 100,000 people
 - Utah has 600,000 visitors at our Air Show and Pat suggested they offer road show sales

 - Concept is that AFA will buy and ship merchandise and tent, we provide manpower and ship leftovers, we have share in revenue
 - Need sure to get high traffic area
 - Kevin Ireland will provide no-cost space
 - o Come June will need volunteers to help man the booth
- Hallway between galleries at museum part for AFA and also tell base story
 - o At the AFA Convention there was a 70th anniversary display
 - USAF and AFA parallel history line
 - We have electronic version of that to be worked into the design
 - Alex to get with Erin and Rob Alexander on design in the hallway
- Veterans Day parade in Layton this Saturday
 - o Ends at Vietnam replica memorial / Gentile with some ceremony to recognize memorial at 1300
- Activity plan needs to be hit hard
 - Use that to build budget
 - o Discuss at next meeting is there something else out there for revenue generation, promo, etc
 - Chili cook-off at Baptist Church again
 - Suggestion made for Go Fund Me page for website for donations
 - We can do this on our website already without fee
 - Also of note AEF is registered with Amazon smile
 - Sponsored dinner at Rovali's suggested

- o Bob approached to host a meal night for guys in barracks
 - Opportunity presented at Military Affairs committee
- Financial plan, activity plan, roster need to be completed for stipend
 - o Randy needs to finalize roster on AFA website
- Museum fundraising for 3rd gallery to bring big airplanes under cover
